Chapter 10

Redemption

Question: Is redemption still happening in our society, and where can we see it? What does redemption mean, and is there a Biblical basis for it?

King David, who wrote many of the Psalms was a close descendent of Ruth and Boaz. We will talk about them a little later. David revealed some very interesting insights about our place with God.

"He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. I will say of the Lord, 'He is my refuge and my fortress; my God, in Him I will trust." Psalm 91:1-2

Where is the secret place? Do you realize that you have one? To me, it is where God covers me over in His glory and I am close to Him, and I can minister to Him and be ministered to by Him. It is a literal fortress, a refuge from the world, and from danger. If you are imprisoned by injustice right now, this secret place is still yours. You just except it by faith. I was thinking about Jake Lang who was imprisoned for Jan. 6 back in 2020 and is still being held in limbo without Constitutional rights. Even in a jail cell, Jake can have a secret place. There are many others like him, and they all need to be on our prayer list. I am thinking of Donald Trump, and his indictments and how that must feel and what he must think about it. Right now, he could be comforted by words from different Psalms. No person ever needed a secret place of prayer and fellowship with God more than President Trump.

Christ is our Redeemer, and He has purchased us with His blood, and He has brought us back into good standing with our Father, and He has sent us His Holy Spirit. So go with me now in the Spirit and see what you have in that realm and where you have been redeemed to.

"For in the time of trouble He shall hide me in His pavilion; In the secret place of His tabernacle He shall hide me; He shall set me high upon a rock. And now my head shall be lifted up above my enemies all around me; therefore, I will offer sacrifices of joy in His tabernacle; I will sing, yes, I will sing praises to the Lord." Psalm 27:5-6

I speak here as the author of this book, and I tell you that like David, I have received my pavilion from God in the spirit realm. Inside the pavilion is my secret place, and it is also called a tabernacle. In this Holy place with God, I am lifted high above my enemies, and I can see them from God's perspective. I am hidden with God in Christ, and we are one together, and I am at total peace, and in my pavilion I am rejoicing and singing to Him who is my greatest love. In this place, I will sing praises to Him. I can also pray in intercession over my Nation, and with my spoken words, in my pavilion, I disrupt and make trouble for my enemies, which includes spiritual princes of darkness who control nations and Presidents and the media, and I can bring damage to the evil beings and thwart their latest scheme, but they cannot make out where I am in my secret place with the Most High inside of my pavilion, my tabernacle of praise. God keeps me secret, and covered in darkness to any eyes who are not friendly, so I am safe. No one need fear when they are doing God's will and praying His will in any situation; all you need is your own faith.

I am encouraging you to take the verses I am sharing and these prophetic words and receive your secret place in God. These revelations are from the words of David, a man after God's own heart. He saw what I see and he voiced and wrote it, and you can make them yours, and then from the hour you first believed, this will all be a reality for you too as it is for me. This is an activation for you if you desire it.

"Oh, how great is Your goodness, which You have laid up for those who fear You, which You have prepared for those who trust in You in the presence of the sons of men! You shall hide them in the secret place of Your presence from the plots of man; you shall keep them secretly in a pavilion from the strife of tongues." Psalm 31:19-20

Maybe you think I have lost it. But I say that when I am driving my car, my pavilion is around me, and in a big crowd of people, I am located inside the secret place, and when threatened, I have a spiritual structure just as real as a physical wall, but it is of that spiritual realm and not this natural one, and realities of that realm spill over into this one, because my Father causes it. And this is all in my redemption, for I am redeemed unto God, and the benefits

of Heaven and the Kingdom of God belong to me. I am safe until my destiny on earth is done.

People even have trouble plotting against me, as they get confused just trying, and the evil one does not even know my location. For my tabernacle and pavilion is where I do my battle from and release my prayers out into the heavenlies. But the biggest reason that I have what I say here is because these words are in the Bible and I believe them and so did David, and that makes them real for me and manifested unto me. The fathers of old had God's hand serving and helping them and they conquered without lifting a weapon. I enjoy the same supernatural help.

"For they did not gain possession of the land by their own sword, nor did their own arm save them; but it was Your right hand, Your arm, and the light of Your countenance, because You favored them." Psalm 44:3

The light of His countenance is His glory which is the building material of my pavilion and the shield of His glory that He surrounds me with. "But You, O Lord, are a shield for me, my glory and the One who lifts up my head."
Psalm 3:3

God calls us a glorious Church. Jesus has given us His glory. (John 17:22) We possess His glory inside of us, and we walk in it, and use it, and release it in our dominion. When Jesus came to live in us, He brought everything with Him. The glory of miracles, signs and wonders belongs to us; raising the dead, curing disease and bringing miracles in our Nation to correct things, to drive out corruption, and to set the ship upright again.

A Redemption story, not so spiritual, but a good example of redemption.

I was watching a movie about a group who came out west on a wagon train. That movie is called The Way West, with Kirk Douglas and Richard Widmark. In two of the families on the wagon train were two teens, a young man and a young woman. They became friends, but the woman was very pretty and the boy was not so handsome. So they spoke a lot, but he was smitten with her and she had eyes for others. She no doubt liked the attention. On the trip from

Missouri to Oregon, this girl got involved with a married man. The married man was having problems with His wife. In an incident that happened, the married man shot a small Native American boy by accident because the small boy was wearing a wolf skin, and he was mistaken for a wolf. The natives, who were great in numbers, were angered and demanded justice, so to save all the people, the leader of the wagon train hanged the married man so the natives could watch and that ended the crisis.

It turned out that the young woman was pregnant by the married man, who was now dead, and she could not go to her parents, so she went to the young man who loved her. She told him and he said he didn't mind, and he would marry her. She said that she did not love him. But he said, you can learn to love me. Eventually, she agreed to marry him, and a big wedding was planned with the wagon train people. She was so happy. But still no one knew she was pregnant. I guess they both thought that the baby would just come along, and everyone would think it hers and the young man's baby. But the bitter wife of the dead man came in right in the middle of the ceremony, and stopped it, and said the young bride was pregnant. The silence was deafening. The bride's parents looked shocked, and so did his parents. All the crowd were looking at the young pregnant bride with mounting disgust. This was the 1800's. Being pregnant before marriage was a huge stigma.

The bitter wife of the dead man said, ask her if this is true. The young bride said, "I will not deny it. Yes, it is true." More long silence. Her life was about to take a downturn. At this moment, her future was hanging in the balance. But the silence had lasted long enough. The young man, who loved her, spoke up. "Yes, she is pregnant alright, and that is my baby. And now let's get on with this wedding." His attitude set everyone at ease, including the parents. The bride looked at him with...love. She was redeemed. Her young man had smoothed it over, and he would fight anyone who made an issue. The bitter woman skulked away and her scheme to ruin everything and ruin the girl failed, because of the love of this young man. The young man took her sin upon himself. His love was monumental. (I do recommend this movie, if just for this scene.)

The story of Ruth and Boaz is a beautiful and true tale from the Bible and found in Ruth Chapters 1-4. It is worth the read if you have never read it. It is a story of Redemption. It is simple. Ruth redeemed Naomi. Boaz redeemed Ruth. Both Ruth and Boaz lived in Bethlehem and became David's great grandparents, and they were in the direct lineage of Jesus. There are truths and happenings in their story that pleased the heart of God.

This is what happened in their story: A man named Judah from Bethlehem went to live in the country of Moab with his wife, Naomi, and their two sons. This was because there was a famine in Israel. Their sons took two Moabite women to be their wives. Judah then died. This is a rough thing, for in those days, a widow had a hard plight without her husband to support her. To make matters even worse, both of Naomi's sons also died, leaving Naomi and the two daughters-in-law to fend for themselves. Naomi heard that the Lord had given food to her people back in her country and she decided to return there. Naomi then told the two daughters-in-laws to return to their mother's houses in Moab and thereby they might find other husbands. If they stayed with Naomi, their future would be quite bleak. One daughter-in-law kissed her goodbye, but the other one did not. That was Ruth. (Ruth 1)

Ruth was a Moabitess, and a little research into this nation of Moabites reveals that they descended from a man named Moab. In Genesis 19:30-38, many generations before Naomi and Ruth, Abraham's nephew Lot had two daughters that had got him drunk and both slept with him, and each one conceived a child. This was their intent, even though it was incest, and this might be expected from two women that were partly raised in Sodom and Gomorrah and in its moral depravity. One of the two children from Lot's daughters was called Moab. His descendants became the nation of Moab. But the nation of Moab is again mentioned in Numbers 22 and 23, when their king Balak asks Balaam to put a curse on the Israelites. As a result, God cursed the nation of Moab for several reasons including sexual immorality and worshipping idols. In Deuteronomy 23:3, God said: "An Ammonite or Moabite shall not enter the assembly of the Lord; even to the tenth generation none of his descendants shall enter the assembly of the Lord forever,"

Now that we see the ancestry background of these two Moabite women, we can continue this story. Ruth would not leave Naomi to an uncertain fate. "And she (Naomi) said, "Look, your sister-in-law has gone back to her people and to her gods; return after your sister-in-law." But Ruth said: "Entreat me not to leave you, or to turn back from following after you; For wherever you go, I will go; and wherever you lodge, I will lodge; your people shall be my people, and your God, my God. Where you die, I will die, and there will I be buried. The Lord do so to me, and more also, If anything but death parts you and me." Ruth 1:15-17 You have got to love Ruth. She is a rare gem. She reminds me of the young man from the wagon train story. But that was just fiction, this is real life. This was a true daughter to Naomi. This was Godly, and don't think God didn't notice. Ruth was redeeming Naomi, a widow in trouble and all alone in the world. And, these were the actions of a Moabite, a people not allowed by God to enter the assembly of the Lord forever. Ruth put Naomi first, and herself last. I am heading to a conclusion with this chapter on the prosecutions of Donald Trump and the election and the people of America who will pray and believe God for true justice.

The story of Ruth does not end here. Naomi and Ruth return to Bethlehem and Ruth decides to go glean from the barley fields for food for her and Naomi. Gleaning was a practice of the poor to go into a field after the reapers were done, seeking to find leftover crops and take home the leavings. God had led her to the fields of a wealthy man named Boaz, who noticed her and how hard she was working. Boaz was impressed with her and approached her and told her that she was welcome to his fields, and to stay close to the women reapers, and to freely drink the water provided for his workers. Boaz did all this despite being told by the reapers that Ruth was a foreigner and from Moab. Boaz seemed very protective of Ruth even from their first meeting. I wonder if Ruth being young and no doubt very beautiful had anything to do with this keen interest by Boaz. God was up to something. (Ruth 2)

See this conversation between Ruth and Boaz: "So she fell on her face, bowed down to the ground, and said to him, 'Why have I found favor in your eyes, that you should take notice of me, since I am a foreigner?' And Boaz answered and said to her, 'It has been fully reported to me, all that you have done for your mother-in-law since the death of your husband,

and how you have left your father and your mother and the land of your birth, and have come to a people whom you did not know before. The Lord repay your work, and a full reward be given you by the Lord God of Israel, under whose wings you have come for refuge." Ruth 2:10-12

I believe what most impressed Boaz was Ruth's Godly character. Boaz told his reapers to let extra grain fall on purpose for Ruth while she was gleaning in his fields. When Ruth went back to Naomi with the grain, she told her about Boaz. Naomi was amazed and told Ruth that Boaz was a relative and he had the right to buy back or redeem the property that belonged to Naomi's husband which upon his death passed on to Ruth's husband. But the property had been sold out of the family. The word redeem means to buy back. It was a custom in that day and in Israel for a close relative to be legally able to redeem a property and get it back into the family. Naomi told Ruth what to do and say to Boaz to set in motion Boaz redeeming Ruth and Naomi. Ruth obeyed her and Boaz responded exactly the way a good and honorable man would. The next day he went before the elders at the gate of the city and first found out if another closer relative wanted to redeem the property. When that person decided not to redeem it, Boaz spoke to the elders and the people present and told them of his intention to redeem Naomi's land back for himself and that he would take Ruth to be his wife, and he told all present that they were all witnesses to his words.

This was easy to do for Boaz because he was wealthy. Naomi and Ruth were saved, their future secure, they now had a provider and a kinsman redeemer as the Bible calls it. They joined Boaz as family, and not long after Ruth gave birth to a son for Boaz, and Naomi became the boy's nurse. God had worked all of this out. This was the genealogy of Jesus. They named the boy Obed, and he had a son named Jesse, and Jesse had a son named David, who would be king of Israel. But what about Ruth being a Moabite? Obviously, that was all removed from her by her being redeemed by Boaz, and that could only happen because Ruth exhibited good character and Godly ways in being fiercely loyal to Naomi. God noticed Ruth. God cleansed and forgave Ruth of all ties to Moab or the Moabites. This is prophetic for all people who will come to Jesus Who is our Kinsman Redeemer; as He washes all of us in His Holy Blood of the Cross, and all is forgiven and cleansed of any family bloodline that is unclean

or sin stained. This former Moabitess woman, Ruth, was mentioned in Matthew 3 verse 5b: "Boaz begot Obed by Ruth, Obed begot Jesse, and Jesse begot David the king." These people that God allowed and worked into the bloodline of Jesus as ancestors were Godly people. What an honor for Ruth.

Follow this line of thought: Ruth stayed with and in a sense, redeemed Naomi. Boaz redeemed Ruth. That redemption also redeemed Naomi even further. Boaz had commented to Ruth earlier that she could have had a younger man, because she was young and virtuous and beautiful, but she wanted to be with him. So Boaz, in a sense, was also redeemed in his life to receive a Godly wife like Ruth and get a son like Obed who is David's grandfather. There was a massive amount of sowing and reaping going on in this story, and that is a spiritual law. But we in the Church of Jesus are His Bride, and He is our Kinsman Redeemer, because His lineage is traceable back to Adam, and.....guess it, yes, you got it, our lineage goes back to Adam too. Jesus "bought us back" or, redeemed us, by His very blood.

As I shared in Chapter 3, Donald Trump set out to have the backs of "we the people" of America. He is quite the idealist and visionary, and we needed a man like that, and I believe that God chose and anointed him to be our President. We saw Trump's unique thinking when he campaigned, as we heard his promises, and many of us with eyes opened who were awakened to the truth knew how much we needed him as President. The Church literally prayed him into office. Donald was interested in redeeming America. Not in the sense of buying it back, but rather in the sense of redeeming our problems, and getting the power back in our hands, in the hands of the people. Donald Trump stepped into the job and became a target from the first, even at the beginning of his first campaign, and he took the pot shots from the left, as he set out to improve America for the people.

It is important to point out here that God chose Donald Trump to redeem our problems, we the people, and especially, we the Church of Jesus. We are at fault for almost losing our country to Satan and his evil beings. That should not have been so. We allowed the slippage, the degrading situation over decades while believers enjoyed comforts, and pleasure, and improper priorities, and

we courted evil allowing its manifestation and existence in our land, while all the while, having the spiritual dominion to have been able to stop it all from sliding towards Hell. God picked Donald Trump like He picked Moses for the deliverance from Egypt to clean up the mess that we made. The first order of the day is a Godly repentance by us, the Church, for what we allowed in America. Can you, my reader, take some responsibility in this?

Here is a man now in trouble, #45, and that trouble came as he set out to serve us, and I say every moral man and woman who sees what has gone on here in this Country has a role to now redeem him out of that trouble. America was designed to have the power be in the people's hands, and the left is trying to steal that power from us forever, and one way they are doing so is this methodical, systematic, and deliberate prosecution and persecution of Donald Trump. This is our brother; he is our kinsman. Many of us are more like-minded with him than we are with some of our relatives. President Donald Trump, a wealthy man, was like Boaz, and we, the people, were like Ruth. He, with all of the knowledge and ability that helped him build his fortune, was willing to come alongside us, the people, and do our bidding. But it has cost him now. The tables are turned, and now, he, being up against so much opposition, is like Ruth, and we, the people, patriots, Christians, who are wealthy in our sheer numbers, are like Boaz. Don't you see it? If freedom ever had a bigger movement opportunity, I don't remember it. Here is our opportunity to perform a redemption of sorts, for a good man who we want as our leader. He is asking us for our help. Jesus said if a man wants you to go a mile with him, go two. If he wants your coat, give him your cloak as well. I have poured my heart into this book, and I have shared what I believe God showed me to share. Now the rest is up to the readers.

We learned from the Bud Light incident that we have the power of the purse and can move things along by boycotts and word of mouth influence. It is now time for #45 to reap all the loyalty he sowed to us, and for us to unite as never before and pay him back with a redemption of his issues, simply by letting our voices be heard in Heaven and across the land. Getting votes is not one of his biggest problems. It is getting clear of his persecutors. That is what he needs. We must pray, and we must speak out, and we must use any influence we have, and as we pray and act, let's watch what God can do to save our Nation.

I believe in the American people just like Donald Trump does. I say we are a Country of redeemers. Now that you have read this book, you can understand what he needs maybe a little more clearly. In the Revolution at the birth of our Country, Thomas Paine wrote some documents that made people raise a battle cry. That is my hope for this book. My hope here is that the power of the pen will be mightier than the sword. Remember, spiritual laws of the Word of God side with us as we align with God and His Word and His spiritual laws. God always backs the house, and never an Absolom spirit. In America, the house is the people, and oh what a people we are! The results will be history. As we, the people, with God's help, redeem #45, by helping him become #47, he, as our President, will be used by God to redeem, "We the People."

More Recent Events and Updates to Lies and Injustice:

I wrote this book in March 2024, and I had to use discipline to not alter any of it. I wanted to show how spiritual laws come to pass. So, Chapters 1 to 10 are from month's ago, but now this update is a broken silence by me, the author, at this time, which is August, 2024. Much has gone on. Many of the spiritual laws that I quoted from Scripture have taken effect and manifested. Some of Trump's cases have hit some big bumps and blockages. One prosecutor has been caught in misappropriate behavior which is jeopardizing her case against Donald Trump. A Supreme Court decision has altered Special Counsel Jack Smith's case, and another SCOTUS decision influences the January 6 people's situations for their good. More time will tell more.

The New York trial has been constrained, with the judge putting things out in the future and now talking of finally recusing himself.

Another manifested spiritual law recently is the downfall of Presidential Candidate Joe Biden. He and his Administration had dug pits for Donald Trump, with frivolous prosecutions but the disloyalty of those around him who were his puppeteers took him down. "He who digs a pit will fall into it," Proverbs 26:27a

But the biggest event that saw God and Heaven's laws in action was the assassination attempt on President Trump. He just barely survived that ordeal. A slight turn of his head changed the whole intent and potentially wicked outcome. Everyone is realizing that he had a supernatural experience. I predicted these experiences like this in chapter 3 of this book.

Let me show you this excerpt from Chapter 3 to refresh the concept:

"Now let's see the spiritual law that shows where #45 is getting his supernatural strength.

"If you are reproached for the name of Christ, blessed are you, for the Spirit of glory and of God rests upon you. On their part He is blasphemed, but on your part, He is glorified." 1 Peter 4:14

Notice this says the Spirit of glory rests on Donald Trump. This is the only place in scripture where God's Holy Spirit is called the Spirit of glory. I believe that this title is in relation to the Holy Spirit's role in dispensing and manifesting the glory of God on man. Jesus said, in John 17:22, "I have given them my glory..." That means all born again believers have Jesus' glory inside of them. But then at times, a special Spirit of glory comes over a person and they become entrenched in this magnificent blessing from God. According to the verse, his critics are blaspheming Christ, but on #45's part, God is receiving glory through #45's reaction to the persecution, and his resiliency in it. Therefore, God pours out supernatural glory for the persecuted to stand strong in the face of enemies and trials.

In Hebrews 11:24-26, it says that Moses by faith... esteemed the **reproach of Christ** to be greater riches than the treasures of Egypt. That means that according to spiritual law, found in 1 Peter 4:14, the Spirit of glory and of God rested on Moses. Now note what happened to Moses in Deuteronomy 34:7; his eyes were not dim, and his natural vigor was not abated. And this was at 120 years old. So,

we can see why Donald Trump, at only 77 years old, his natural vigor, strength, and vibrancy is intact, and it is supernatural, and it is a God thing, and it is meant to glorify God. As the author, I suggest that this visible sign from God in #45 will not be the only sign from God that we see in and around this servant of God." Written in March 2024

Note in the last sentence that I said in Chapter 3 last March that #45's inner power and resiliency and die-hard attitude would not be the only sign from God that we see in and around this servant of God.
